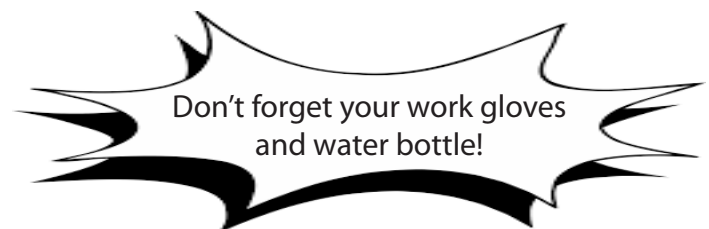
Before you pick up your fellow Arrowmen and head to camp, here are a few things you need to know:
