Timucuan- Waterfront

- Cut all brush within the boating area and remove
- Cut low branches off trees and remove
- Move Docks in closer to shore- if Michael Filz attends to facilitate

Elemukulek- Install erosion control (railroad ties) on the trail that leads to the Aquatic Center from Meninak

Apieka- Work on nature trails- clearing, cutting trees or limbs out of the way, trimming growth back, raking

Saturiwa- Pressure wash Aquatic Center, Campsite Bathrooms, bathhouse A, B and C, staff bathhouse and waterfront bath house inside and out

Seminole- Remove and install new doors at campsite pavilions

Onathequa- Deep cleaning of Taylor Food prep/ storage areas

Outina- Work with Seminole to remove and install new doors at campsite pavilions

Osceola- Reclaim select areas of forest.

Oklawaha- Clean out all buildings and Campsite Pavilions. Wash off and clean mattresses in Pavilions

Oglala- Remove brush created by cutting off the Laurel Oaks. Most of the brush should be on main roads
