Driving Policy – No driving will be permitted on camp without a valid, color-coded pass. Passes will be distributed as needed only to drivers with a valid license and insurance card. If you do not receive a pass, please park your vehicle in the camp parking lot for the duration of the event. **Youth Younger than 18 cannot drive once on camp**; youth aged 18-21 cannot drive passengers under 21; adults over 21 may drive with passengers. Passengers and drivers **must wear seatbelts**.

Camping Policy –Please remember to camp with your chapter. A committee with prior approval from the lodge adviser may camp away from their Chapter because of Committee obligations.

Check-In/Check-Out Policy - If any youth under 18 leaves camp before Sunday morning, he must check out at the Ames Lodge and check back in upon return. The BSA two- deep leadership policy must be followed. Youths aged 18-21 may leave camp alone with lodge adviser approval.
